

# How to create a skin

## Introduction

Wizr media server supports skins. That means you can change wizr's appearance very fast. All versions of Wizr are bundled with only one skin : « linkplayer ». We are going to learn how to design new skins.

First, you need to understand that each skin comes in two flavours :

- a SD (standard definition) version
- a HD (high definition) version, also called compact browser on some players

So you need to create both versions when you design a skin.

Second, a skin is a simple HTML page, because Syabas-based players are using their internal web browser to show server pages. The bundled browser is not as advanced as Internet Explorer 6, so don't try to use Flash, javascript etc.... To design a skin, you need basic knowledge of HTML code.



« *Simplicity* » skin


## 1. Background images

For each skin, you should have 3 different backgrounds, all 720x576 :

- ***back.jpg***  
This is the main background image. For SD version, this image will be cropped at the bottom. So consider that the image is virtually 720x480.
- ***back-delete.jpg***  
This image is the background when you are in delete mode.
- ***option\_menu.jpg***  
This image is the background when you are in wizr's options page.

Note : you can have only one background image instead of three, but this way all your pages (browser, delete mode, options page) will have the same background. To do this, you'll need to modify html code to refer to *back.jpg* where it referred to *back-delete.jpg* and *option\_menu.jpg*.

Here is the way to create background with you favourite editor :



## 2. File structure

---

To modify HTML files, it's better not to use Wysiwyg editor, but Notepad. Thus you need to know how to code in HTML. You can use bold, italic, tables, pictures, links etc..... Note that your player has only one font, but you can set different sizes.

Note : don't use javascript or flash.

Wizd is building HTML pages on the fly. To build a page, it is using the following HTML pages :

*For details view, with one line per file*

- |                      |   |
|----------------------|---|
| <b>head.html</b>     | this is a static part of the page, at the top   |
| <b>line_XXX.html</b> | wizd is using the correct file according to the file type it needs to show.<br>For example if wizd need to show a JPG file in the browser,<br>it will use line_jpeg.html. XXX refers to the skin line in Mime part of settings. |
| <b>tail.html</b>     | this is a static part of the page, at the bottom  |

*For thumbnail view, with rows and columns*

- thumb\_head.html**
- thumb\_XXX.html** (repeated for each file in the row)
- thumb\_row.html** (between each row)
- thumb\_XXX.html** (repeated for each file in the next row)
- thumb\_tail.html**

For example, if we decompose a page :



*The XXX is one of the following:*

chapter	Chapters on DVD chapter view
delete	Used for all files in delete mode
dir	Directories
document	Used for text or html files
image	Image files, other than JPEG
iso	ISO and IMG dvd images
jpeg	JPEG image files
movie	All movie files
music	All music files
musiclist	Music playlist files (typically the same as "music")
playlist	Video playlist files (typically the same as "video")
svi	Video format used by Samsung for playing video on portable video players
pseudo	???
unknown	Used for any files which don't match anything else, and as a default if the desired skin file is missing
url	Used for internet shortcut files from Internet Explorer

### 3. Syabas browser

Apart from HTML commands, the Web browser of your HD player supports some special tags created by Syabas. You can use them in your HTML files.

#### 3.1 Full Screen Browser

Trigger the browser to display in full screen mode :

**<meta SYABAS-FULLSCREEN>** (between <head> and </head>)

#### 3.2 Background image

Defines the browser's background image :

**<meta SYABAS-BACKGROUND="back.jpg">** (between <head> and </head>)

#### 3.3 OnLoadSet

This attribute emulates the Javascript *OnLoad* event handler. This attribute is supported in BODY tag only. It enables the page to focus a specific link or input object once the page is loaded :

**<BODY ONLOADSET=name>**

### 3.4 OnFocusSet

This attribute emulates the Javascript *OnFocus* event handler. This attribute is supported in a link object only. When navigating onto a link object that holds a onFocusSet handler, the focus will be changed to the targeted link or input object :

```
<A HREF=url ONFOCUSSET=name>Link</A>
```

*Example:*

```
<A HREF="#A1" ONFOCUSSET="link2">ABC</A>
```

```
<A HREF="#A2" name="link2">XYZ</A>
```

When user reaches the link ABC (by navigating using arrow keys of the remote controller for instance), the focus will immediately jump to link XYZ, which holds the name "link2".

### 3.5 OnFocusLoad

This attribute emulates the Javascript *OnFocus* event handler. This attribute is supported in a link object only. When navigating onto a link that holds a onFocusLoad handler, the focus will be changed to the targeted link, then immediately the targeted page is loaded :

```
<A HREF=url ONFOCUSLOAD>Link</A>
```

*Example:*

```
<A HREF="/page2.htm" ONFOCUSLOAD>ABC</A>
```

When user navigates onto the link ABC, immediately the targeted URL is accessed (page2.htm is loaded).

### 3.6 Customise Hi-Lite Color

This attribute allow user to customise the default hi-lite color (GOLD color with BLACK Text) :

```
<BODY FOCUSCOLOR="#RRGGBB" FOCUSTEXT="#RRGGBB">
```

### 3.7 TVID

This feature provides an easier user navigation on the browser. User can interact with the browser through remote control with minimum key strokes. With a TVID, you can press a button on your remote to perform a specific action.

Here are some TVID : play, zoom, pgup, pgdn, esc, stop, repeat, green, blue, yellow, red

All TVID are not working on every player, you need to test ....

*Example :*

```
<a href="<!--WIZD_INSERT_CURRENT_PATH_LINK-->option=thumb" tvid="zoom">
```

You can see that this html link has a tvid defined : zoom. When you press the zoom button on your remote, it will go to that link.

## 4. wizd\_skin.conf

---

The skin directory should contain a configuration file which defines the number of lines per page for "details" view, and the number of rows and columns for "thumbnail" view. In addition it defines the maximum width of the limited-length file names used in the display. The "menu\_icon\_type" defines the default file extension for the automatic icon name generation use by the *WIZD\_INSERT\_LINE\_FILE\_IMAGE* keyword (see below).

page_line_max	18
menu_filename_length_max	75
thumb_row_max	5
thumb_column_max	6
thumb_filename_length_max	24
menu_icon_type	gif

## 5. Wizr internal tags

You can use the following tags in your HTML pages. They'll be replaced automatically with the correct information.

This keyword is a special function which returns an appropriate link for a thumbnail image for the file. For jpeg and image files it will return a link to the file. For directories, video, and music files, it will look for a matching thumbnail image from the following list, where "%s" is replaced with the base filename of the file (without the original extension) :

- tn\_%s.jpg
- tn\_%s.png
- tn\_%s.gif
- %s.jpg
- %s.png
- %s.gif
- %s/Folder.jpg
- %s/AlbumArtSmall.jpg

If none of these match an existing thumbnail file, then a generic default skin icon is used. For details mode, this will be "icon\_\*.gif" where the "\*" is replaced with the file type (just like the line\_\*.html and thumb\_\*.html files) and the "gif" is defined by the menu\_icon\_type defined in the wizd\_skin.conf file. For thumbnail mode, this will be "thumb\_\*.gif".
